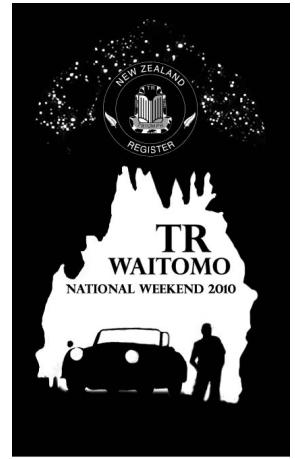




TR Register New Zealand Inc. National Weekend 2010 25 – 28 February 2010

Thursday 25 February

- Morning – 6pm free time to explore Waitomo – maybe have a go at one of the Waitomo Adventure tours – for details ask at the Waitomo i-site or explore the web link <http://waitomocaves.com/newwebpages/iactivities.htm>
- **From 1pm** Collection of Rally Packs at Waitomo Caves Hotel
- As people are arriving at various times today, you will need to organise your own meals. There are a number of pleasant options in Waitomo village
- **6.00** Noggin and natter Thursday evening Waitomo Caves Hotel. Some complimentary nibbles will be provided. The infamous Grope Box will be available throughout the weekend to puzzle and mystify you...
- **7.30 Forum** TR Register Forum to be held at Waitomo Caves hotel – your chance to hear about the TR Register, and to discuss any ideas, ask questions etc regarding the TR Register

Friday 26 February

- Collection of Rally Packs Waitomo Caves Hotel until 9am
- **8.30am** Gather at Waitomo Domain (opposite I-Site) - please park where instructed by helpers and put your judging sheet under your windscreen wiper if you have entered the Concours
- **8.30 – 11.30** Concours Judging / People's Choice
Feel free to make use of the toilets/facilities in the Domain Clubrooms.
Toilets also located at i-Centre
 - You may wish to just admire the cars
 - Don't forget to make your People's choice (forms in your rally packs) – vote for the TR on display today that you most admire
 - Across the road at the Waitomo i-Site is the award-winning Waitomo Caves Discovery Centre that explores the above and below ground treasures of Waitomo. Visitors can also see cave crystals, stalactites and stalagmites, moa skeletons, fossils and a giant ammonite. Try some of the hands on activities, or there is a cave crawl for the more adventurous. The Centre features a 17-minute multi-media show "Arachnocampa Luminosa", another must experience for cave visitors that describes the lifecycle of the New Zealand Glowworm.
 - Or just chill out and do your own thing ☺
 - A light morning tea will be provided in the Domain Clubrooms during the Concours judging

- **11.30** Depart Waitomo Scenic tour to Marokopa, spectacular roads and scenery and places of interest with stops along the way. Lunch at Marokopa
- **6.30** Evening buffet meal and natter at Waitomo Caves Hotel (Fred Mace Room). Presentation of Concours Awards
