

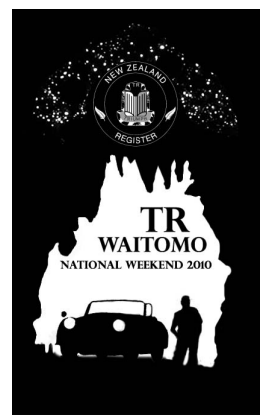


## TR Register New Zealand Inc. National Weekend 2010

**Waikato-Coromandel-Rotorua Tour**  
Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> February - Friday 5<sup>th</sup> March

### Information

(R2 18 December 2009)



Following the support for and success of the Southland Tour after the 2009 National Weekend at Cromwell a tour is planned to follow the 2010 Waitomo National Weekend. The tour will start on Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> February at around 14:30 from the National Weekend Sunday luncheon venue after the final proceedings of the National Weekend are completed.

The final itinerary for the tour is still in the planning stages but below is the outline of a tentative itinerary that the final event is being refined from:

- Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> February:  
After the National Weekend Sunday luncheon drive to Raglan for Sunday night with time to explore before the evening sets in. Overnight Raglan.
- Monday 1<sup>st</sup> March:  
Leave Raglan and set off for Coromandel through Huntly West with a stop to explore the new Hampton Downs racetrack. Then onwards via Te Kauwhata, The Seabird Coast, and Thames. Overnight Coromandel.
- Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> March  
Explore Coromandel, experience a special railway and pottery and then continue down the eastern side of the Coromandel Range through popular seaside resorts. Overnight: Whangamata.
- Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> March  
Explore the Waihi - Karangahake gold field area, maybe visit Hobbit Town and other points of interest before heading for Rotorua. Overnight Rotorua.
- Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> March  
Explore Rotorua area - lakes, thermal activity and more tourist attractions than the number of bits in a TR overdrive. Overnight Rotorua.
- Friday 5<sup>th</sup> March  
Leave Rotorua for a lunch time venue to end the tour and say goodbye to everyone until the next event before heading home.
- Total distance approx 700 - 800km
